## II. <u>Preliminary Site Plan Approval for a proposed 1900 S.F. addition to Mader</u> Construction @, 970 Bullis Rd

#### Contact: Kevin Biddle

Kevin Biddle, President of Mader Construction spoke about the company's plan to add a 1900 sq. ft addition off the back of the existing building. The new addition will house 4 offices, 2 bathrooms with showers and a gym. Exterior will match the existing building. The addition will be connected to the existing front building by a walkway.

#### *EPB* reviewed the checklist:

Documentation- have completed SEOR

Site & Building Details – have stamped survey, property details, layout of buildings, engineered blueprints, building use and design. Mr. Merkle asked about the windows. There will be 2 windows in the offices, they will be like the windows in current building.

Lighting-Chairman Cirocco mentioned to make sure that any lighting has a shield on.

Parking -has more than enough parking

Drainage – town engineer has no concerns

Signage – no new signage

Landscaping – no new landscaping

Water Service & Septic System- need letters from Elma water Department and Erie County Health Department

Fire Department- have approval letter

## II. <u>Preliminary Site Plan Approval for a proposed 1900 S.F. addition to Mader</u> Construction (a), 970 Bullis Rd (continued)

Chairman Cirocco expressed congratulations to Mr. Puleo on being elected to Elma Town Judge.
