Department Reports

Building Inspector Joseph Colern presented the April 2010 building report with 25 permits issued, \$4,263.70 in fees collected with an estimated value of construction of \$561,886.69.

Water Superintendent Eugene Stevenson will have the contract to be signed from Amstar of WNY Inc for the Billington Road water tank project by Friday.

Highway Superintendent Wayne Clark informed the Board that preliminary work for the Briggswood and Jackman culver pipe replacement has been started, the drainage project at the Creek Road Park has started and also the New Bullis drainage project.
