The meeting was opened with the reciting of the Pledge of Allegiance.

Department Reports

Building Inspector Joseph Colern presented the monthly report for February, 2011 with 8 permits issued; fees collected of \$2,888.936 with an estimated value of construction \$702,800.

Water Superintendent Eugene Stevenson informed the Town Board that due to a power surge at the Jamison Road pump station only one pump is working, the control panel has been sent out for repair. NYSEG will be contacted to attend a Work Session regarding numerous power outages.

Highway Superintendent Wayne Clark would like permission to surplus a 1995 John Deere mower. Also rubbish collection will start April 4, with brush pick up on April 18, 2011.
