

5/5/04 Town Board Minutes

A regular meeting of the Elma Town Board was held on Wednesday, May 5, 2004, at 8:00 PM at the Elma Town Hall, 1910 Bowen Road, Elma, New York, with the following members present:

Approximately 39 people attended the meeting.

The meeting was opened with the reciting of the Pledge of Allegiance.

Councilman Powers made the motion and Councilwoman Glownia seconded the motion to approve the minutes from April 21, 2004.
Ayes-5. Noes-0. Carried.

Department Reports

Water Superintendent Eugene Stevenson informed the Town Board that Danny Thompson is off his six-month probation. The Water Department had two breaks this past week 50 Elderberry Lane and 7020 Clinton Street. Also Mr. Stevenson presented the Water Departments Annual Water Quality Report which will be mailed out to all water customers next week.

Councilwoman Glownia made the motion and Councilman Cirocco seconded the motion to approve Danny Thompson as a full time employee at the Water Department, his six-month probation period is complete.

Ayes-5. Noes-0. Carried.

Town Attorney Robert Pierce is working with the Building Department concerning the illegal dumping at the Transfer Station.

Town Engineer Jim Wyzykiewicz informed the Town Board that the State DOT is in the process of cleaning out the ditch on RT 400 near South Blossom Road.

Supervisor Nolan noted that the next rubbish pick up will be June 7th, August 2nd (no brush will be picked up) and October 4th, 2004.

Councilwoman Glowonia made the motion and Councilman Cirocco seconded the motion to issue a Business Use Permit for Saints and Sinners Custom Cycles at 6271 Seneca Street to Ed & Bonnie Sikes, with a negative declaration on a short form SEQR. Building Inspector notes that 5/8" fire sheathing needs to be installed on the workshop ceiling, fire inspection within 30 days of occupancy and a permit for any advertising signs. Ayes-5. Noes-0. Carried.

Councilwoman Glowonia made the motion and Councilman Cirocco seconded the motion to appoint Wayne Clark as Highway Superintendent until December 31, 2004. Ayes-5. Noes-0. Carried.

Supervisor Nolan set a public hearing date of June 2nd, 2004 for the Jamison Road Volunteer Fire Company to amend the Certificate of Incorporation and Drainage District #167 for St. Gabriel Church on Clinton Street.

All have received the Zoning Board Agenda.

Correspondence was received from NYS DOT that on RT 400 from West Seneca to Aurora the speed limit will be 65mph.

Councilman Cirocco made the motion and Councilman Powers seconded the motion to extend the moratorium on Sub Divisions for 60 days. Ayes-5. Noes-0. Carried.

6:00PM.
