TRI-TOWN RECREATION SKI CLUB REGISTRATION:

Iroquois Middle School: Completed registration forms & a check may be taken to Mrs. Boyle in the MS office.

Iroquois High School: Completed registration forms and a check may be taken to Mrs. Marracino in the HS.

Registration Deadline: All registrations are returned to the Iroquois School. Deadline is the end of the school day on Friday, October 31, 2008* A \$10.00 late fee will be charged after 10/31/08. NO registration after 11/7/08.*

NEED THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION TO REGISTER:

One (1) check may be written to: **TRI-TOWN RECREATION** to include ski club and equipment rental. Same check can include ADD-A-PASS fee. No cash will be accepted.

SKI CLUB:

- _____ 1. Complete the KISSING BRIDGE Skiing Application following instructions. The **Student** must sign the application **AND** a **Parent** must also sign if the skier/boarder is under 18 years old.
- _____ 2. Read the TRI-TOWN RECREATION Ski Club Regulation and Agreement. The **Student** must sign the agreement on the bottom of the form. A **Parent** must also sign.
- _____ 3. A check must be payable to TRI-TOWN RECREATION for \$170.00 for the Ski Club program.
- _____ 4. ADD-A-PASS fee can be added to receive a season pass to KB.

EQUIPMENT RENTAL:

- _____ 5. Complete the KISSING BRIDGE Prepaid Rental Registration Form following instructions. Different Rental Forms for skis and snowboards. The **Student** must sign the rental Agreement. A **Parent** must sign the Rental Agreement if the skier/boarder is under 18 years old.
- _____ 6. Add the fee for the appropriate number of equipment rental. Equipment breakage insurance is included in the rental fee. This insurance does not apply to lost or stolen equipment.

TRI-TOWN RECREATION SKI CLUB INFORMATION

Tri-Town Recreation will continue to offer a Ski Club Program to 6TH - 12TH grade students in the Iroquois Central School District.

Ski Club will be skiing at Kissing Bridge for 8 weeks on **THURSDAY EVENINGS**. The group will be skiing from 4:30pm until 8:30pm with lessons from 5:00-6:00pm at the Central Ski Area. Listen to school announcements for the ski club starting date. There will be no skiing on December 25, 2008 and January 1, 2009. There will be no ski club on snow days or if after-school activities are cancelled. Changes in times and dates due to weather conditions will be announced.

The group will LEAVE from the front of each School by 3:30pm and will RETURN to the School by 9:15pm. Chaperones request that parents pick their children up by 9:15pm, so chaperones may also go home. Students not picked up on time will **not** be allowed to ride the bus the following ski date.

BUSES WILL LEAVE KB AT EXACTLY 8:30PM AND ANYONE WHO IS NOT ON THE BUS WILL HAVE TO PROVIDE THEIR OWN TRANSPORTATION HOME.

REGISTRATION DEADLINE: At the end of the school day on Friday, October 31, 2008.*

* A \$10.00 late fee will be charged after 10/31/08. NO registrations after 11/7/08.

SKI CLUB:

Room 101 in the High School have been reserved for ski club members to wait in until the buses arrive to take the group to Kissing Bridge. Middle School participants should listen to announcements for club meeting place. The school has asked all members of the ski club to wait in these designated areas and not wander the halls.

LIMITED ENROLLMENT IN THE SKI CLUB PROGRAM! The ski club program will register only 80 students with their signed agreements and payment. **PAYMENT MUST BE MADE AT TIME OF REGISTRATION.** Due to the limited space available on the buses, spaces for the ski club program may not be reserved. The Club Director has the right to deny any student the chance to participate in our program.

EQUIPMENT:

The equipment van will be parked by the High School tennis courts in the morning until 9am. After 9am, the van will be moved inside the bus garage fence, in the left corner closest to the entrance gate. The van will be open throughout the day, so equipment may be put in properly at various times of the day. **All participants must have their equipment in a bag to eliminate damage to equipment and lost equipment.** Make sure your equipment is placed properly in the van so the doors may be shut. Be careful in the parking lot to avoid damage to other person's cars. **No skies, boards or poles are allowed on the bus.**

Rental equipment will be available from Kissing Bridge to students who do not have their own equipment. The cost for skis is \$80 for 8 rentals (Boards-\$125), \$85 for 10 ski rentals (Boards -\$140), or \$105 for unlimited ski rentals for the current ski season (except holidays). All rental costs include equipment breakage insurance. Insurance does not apply to lost or stolen equipment. There will be no refunds on rental equipment once the program starts.

RENTAL INFORMATION AND REGISTRATION FORMS SHOULD BE PICKED UP IMMEDIATELY AT THE MIDDLE OR HIGH SCHOOL OFFICE.

THE RENTAL EQUIPMENT FORM (FOR SKIS OR BOARDS) MUST BE COMPLETED, SIGNED BY A PARENT, & MUST ACCOMPANY PAYMENT UPON REGISTRATION TO THE SKI CLUB PROGRAM.

- ◆ **The 2008-2009 Ski Club program will cost \$170.00 per student.** This fee includes an 8 week ski program (including open skiing and 6 - 1 hour lessons), the cost of transportation (including gasoline and bus drivers), and ski and Colden Tubing Co. discount coupons. Refund requests must be made in writing prior to the program start. There will be no refunds on the ski club program once the program begins.

TICKETS:

- * Tickets will be issued on the bus. No one will be permitted to ride the bus unless they are a member of the ski club. Tickets can not be given or sold to anyone who is not a member of the ski club.
- * **Tickets will not be given to club members who are not taking the bus without written permission from a parent.** ALL written permissions will be checked before club member receives their ticket. Written permission must include phone number in which the parent can be reached at 3:15pm.

Tri-Town Recreation Ski Club 2008 – 2009 Regulations and Agreement

To: All Members of the Tri-Town Recreation Ski Club and Their Parents
 From: Club Director and the Tri-Town Recreation Director
 Re: Regulations Governing Ski Club Participants

ANY INFRACTION OF THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS WILL RESULT IN IMMEDIATE AND AUTOMATIC EXPULSION OF THE PARTY AND PARTIES INVOLVED FROM THIS PROGRAM. THERE WILL BE NO EXCEPTIONS AND UNDER THESE CIRCUMSTANCES, NO REFUNDS WILL BE POSSIBLE.

PROHIBITED:

1. Possession, consumption, and/or under the influence of alcohol.
2. Possession, use, and/or under the influence of any illegal drug or narcotic.
3. Smoking on the bus.
4. Loud or distracting behavior or horseplay, creating hazardous situation on the bus and/or at the ski resort.
5. Any behavior and/or attitude that endangers or threatens the safety and well being of others.
6. Transfer or sale of ski school lift tickets.
7. All transportation to and from the ski resort must be on the scheduled bus. **NO private transportation will be permitted without written permission from parent.** The ski club is not responsible for youth taking alternative transportation. **ALL written permissions will be checked before club member receives their ticket. Written permission must include phone number a parent can be reached at 3:15pm.**
8. The three (3) bars at Kissing Bridge are off limits to all ski club participants.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

1. Any damage to buses or equipment will be the responsibility of the offending party.
2. Tri-Town Recreation Ski Club is not responsible for lost or stolen items. A ski/board check and lockers are available at Kissing Bridge.
3. Ski Club participants need to be picked up on time when the bus returns to the school. Participants not picked up on time will NOT be allowed to ride the bus the following ski date.
4. Equipment should be put in a bag to eliminate damage and lost equipment.
NO skis, boards or poles are allowed on the bus. NO EXCEPTIONS.
5. Refer to the Drug and Alcohol Policy from Tri-Town Recreation and Kissing Bridge. (See policy on back)
6. **Buses leave Kissing Bridge at exactly 8:30pm.** Anyone who is not on the bus will have to provide his or her own transportation home. Tri-Town Recreation is not responsible for youth at Kissing Bridge after 8:30pm or traveling home after a missed bus.
7. The Club Director has the final say on all incidents.

ALCOHOL AND DRUG POLICY

From Kissing Bridge and Tri-Town Recreation

From Kissing Bridge:

Drinking, drugs and skiing/boarding do not mix. Individuals who combine these activities are a threat to themselves and to all others in the area. Kissing Bridge has an obligation to provide our customers with a safe enjoyable skiing/boarding experience. We cannot provide this if we do not recognize and act upon irresponsible actions involving alcohol and drugs.

Kissing Bridge and club organizers have the right and obligation to determine who is permitted to use the facilities. We will abide by New York State Laws regarding the use of drugs and alcohol and will excuse from the premise any individuals in violation of the controlled substance and alcohol laws. If necessary, we will pursue arrest and conviction.

Any individual determined to be a threat to the public will have their skiing/boarding privileges revoked for a period of time deemed appropriate by Kissing Bridge. Should the violator belong to an organized program, this person will forfeit the balance of privileges for the remainder of the season. When minors are involved, Kissing Bridge will call the individual's parents/guardians, and request that they pick up their child up at the ski area. No refunds will be available to the individual or the group.

All Club Directors and chaperones will stress the importance of this policy to all club members so that there will be no misunderstanding should a problem occur.

From Tri-Town Recreation:

Tri-Town Recreation Ski Club agrees and will adhere to the above Alcohol and Drug Policy issued by Kissing Bridge. In addition, if any Tri-Town Recreation ski club participant has drugs or alcohol in their possession or is under the influence of either drugs or alcohol:

1. Parents of the participant will be informed of the violation immediately from Kissing Bridge. Parents must immediately pick up their child from Kissing Bridge.
2. The participant will forfeit the balance of the ski club program and No refund will be issued.
3. The participant will not be allowed to sign up for future ski club programs.

RESPONSIBILITY OF SKIERS* AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK

In consideration of permission to use the Kissing Bridge Ski Area in Glenwood, NY, I expressly acknowledge:

1. The Ski Area shall not be liable for any personal injury to me and/or damage to my personal property.
2. I have read and understand the duties of passengers and skiers (sec. 18-104 of the NYS General Obligations Law), have retained a copy (pg.2) and agree to abide by it.
3. Lift tickets, lessons and programs are not transferable. They may not be sold, traded or given away on penalty of forfeiture without refund.
4. All lift tickets, lessons, rentals and skiing program sales are final. There are no refunds under any circumstances.
5. I grant permission to Kissing Bridge to use any photograph, video, picture, recording or any other record of my use of its facilities for any legitimate purpose.
6. At my request, I can receive a copy of article 18-NYS General Obligations Law from the Ticket Centre.

WARNING TO SKIERS

DOWNHILL SKIING LIKE MANY OTHER SPORTS, CONTAIN INHERENT RISKS INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO THE RISK OF PERSONAL INJURY, INCLUDING CATASTROPHIC INJURY OR DEATH, OR PROPERTY DAMAGE, WHICH MAY BE CAUSED BY:

Variations in terrain or weather conditions or surface or subsurface snow, ice, bare spots or areas of thin cover, moguls, ruts bumps or other persons using the facilities, and or rocks, forest growth, debris, branches, trees, roots, stumps or other natural objects or man-made objects that are incidental to the provision or maintenance of a ski facility in New York State.

New York Law imposes a duty on you to become apprised of, and understand, the risks inherent in the sport of skiing, which are set forth above, so that you may make an informed decision whether to participate in skiing notwithstanding the risks. New York Law also imposes additional duties upon you, to which you must adhere, for the purpose of avoiding injury caused by any of the risks inherent in skiing

IF YOU ARE NOT WILLING TO ASSUME ALL OF THESE RISKS AND ABIDE BY ALL OF THESE DUTIES, YOU MUST NOT PARTICIPATE IN SKIING AT THIS SKI AREA have read and understand the above warning to skiers. By signing I signify that I am aware of, and accept the risks inherent to the sport of skiing and indicated in the Warning to Skiers. In addition, I understand that the programs sold by Kissing Bridge are not refundable.

*Kissing Bridge defines skiers/skiing as snowsports that may include the use of skis, snowboards and all other snow sliding devices.
